



## PODCASTS

Did you know you can listen to KQED whenever and wherever you want?



### What are podcasts?

Podcasts are like taking the radio with you anywhere you go and listening to your favorite shows whenever you want. They've been around since the early 2000s but have really become more prominent in the last couple of years — and KQED has some of the best! Whether you're curious about the Bay Area's hidden stories (*Bay Curious*), interested in the future of learning (*MindShift*), like to stay connected to California's diverse issues (*The California Report*) or want to explore something else, KQED has got you covered.

### How do I listen?

Most people listen on their phones or in their cars. There are podcast apps that come already installed on every phone. On iPhone, it's simply called "Podcasts," and on Android, it's "Google Podcasts." A lot of people choose to listen on other apps like Spotify too! Here's how to get started:

1. Open your podcast app of choice.
2. Search for your favorite KQED podcast or radio show or simply type in **KQED**.
3. Choose an episode that strikes your interest, and enjoy!



## One Mystery Queen Investigates Another


My favorite blonde historian is back for more sleuthing! With a vast portfolio that includes popular KQED TV shows like *Lucy Worsley Investigates*; *Lucy Worsley's Royal Myths and Secrets*; and *Blitz Spirit with Lucy Worsley*, there is no person more qualified (in my opinion) to investigate the ultimate mystery queen, the late Dame Agatha Christie, than our famed British author/curator/television presenter herself.

Christie, a writer during the Golden Age of detective fiction, is often referred to as the "Queen of Crime." Having written an overwhelming amount of work comprising more than 66 detective novels and 14 short story collections (including every plot to the crime-solving adventures of *Agatha Christie's Poirot*,

which airs every Friday at 8pm on KQED Plus), Christie is a literary record-holder. According to the Guinness World Records, Agatha Christie is the world's best-selling author of all time, having sold more than two billion copies.

When considering the sheer amount of work Christie put into this world, one could only wonder how her mind came up with so much material. That is why Lucy Worsley has set out to explore the enigma of Agatha Christie over the span of three episodes. Watch episode one of ***Agatha Christie: Lucy Worsley on the Mystery Queen*** on **Sunday, December 3, at 8pm on KQED 9** to uncover the complex woman whose life and work reflect the upheavals of the 20th century.

### DID YOU KNOW? San Francisco's Own Literary Detective

- Samuel Dashiell Hammet, who was a San Francisco detective before becoming a writer, named his lead detective in *The Maltese Falcon*, Sam Spade, after himself.
- The noir fiction classic is set in San Francisco, and investigator Sam Spade lives at 891 Post St., which was the real-life address of the author in the late 1920s.
- John's Grill, the restaurant from which Sam ordered "chops, baked potato and sliced tomatoes," still serves the iconic menu item today.
