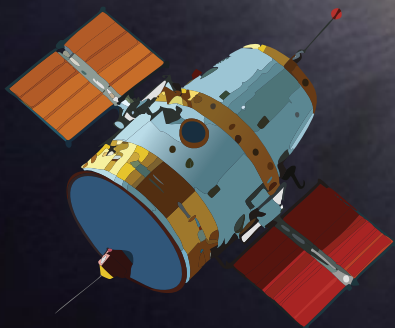

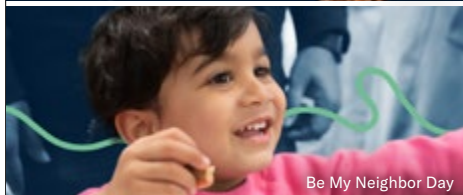

Culinary indulgence is in full bloom this spring as *Check, Please! Bay Area* makes a splash with a new season and KQED's new digital food series, *Beyond the Menu*, debuts to tell the history of our favorite dishes.

First, catch up with host and wine connoisseur Leslie Sbrocco for Season 19 of *Check, Please!* as it ventures into the new, delicious territory of the Monterey Bay Area. Food enthusiasts share their recommendations for the best meals from Carmel Valley to Capitola, and they do not disappoint. From its *You 2.0* series to a recent in-depth exploration of how partisanship works, the show “explores the unconscious patterns that drive human behavior.” Host Shankar Vedantam eschews easy answers and you-can-do-it platitudes in favor of facts, science and nuance. Expert guests weigh in on human memory, attention spans, feelings — and how to make the most of our inevitable mistakes. One episode considers this thought-provoking question: “What would Socrates do?” It’s a show for cleaning the house or the car and maybe even the mind.

The Bay

When one of your appliances or electronics breaks, do you buy a new one or try to fix it yourself? Many people find the challenge of fix-it-yourself projects so daunting, they opt to replace the broken item. But our disposable culture doesn’t have to be the norm. In the episode “A Growing ‘Right to Repair’ Culture in California” on KQED’s podcast *The Bay*, Azul Dahlstrom-Eckman explores the new “Right to Repair” law, which intends to make it easier for everyday people to fix their own stuff. By requiring increased transparency and information from manufacturers, the law is designed to give consumers what they need to handle repairs themselves.

During the episode, Dahlstrom-Eckman takes us to a fix-it clinic in Redwood City where volunteers are teaching do-it-yourself skills to others in the community. Don’t miss this fascinating look at an expanding solution for sustainability.

NOVA: Great American Eclipse

With Earth Day approaching, April is the perfect time to celebrate the natural world. And this year, nature is offering something truly special: a total solar eclipse. In anticipation of this extraordinary cosmic event, *NOVA* is going inside the phenomenon, exploring how and why eclipses happen. Until 2044, this will be the last total eclipse we'll see, so tune in to learn how to watch it safely — and, for anyone who will be in the path of the eclipse, how to prepare for four minutes of complete darkness. (The last American eclipse in 2017 plunged witnesses into darkness for only half as long.)

This episode is an opportunity to follow scientists as they work to unlock secrets of our Sun — from why its atmosphere is hundreds of times hotter than its surface to what causes solar storms and how we might one day predict them. Having never seen an eclipse myself, I am going to be positioned in my backyard and ready to experience this rare astronomical event with my dog at my side. What could be more appropriate for celebrating nature's spectacular glory than the companionship of another species? Watch the episode on **Wednesday, April 3, at 8pm on KQED 9.**
