# Season 9 Finale of Grantchester on MASTERPIECE

Shocking discoveries are coming to light on *Grantchester*. After seven rollercoaster episodes, the crime drama will treat viewers to a thrilling Season 9 finale on **Sunday, August 4**, at **9pm** on **KQED 9**. It's been an eventful season so far: DI Geordie has teamed up with new vicar, Alphy, to solve the ever-increasing number of local murders, while Alphy's unexpected arrival has forced some residents to reflect on their own implicit bias. This season also journeyed into new territory as the characters began to explore topics such as gender politics in the workplace and the meaning of faith in the community. Filled with charming, romantic storylines as well as puzzling new crimes (including a mystifying disappearance and an abandoned baby), the season positions us for a finale that is bound to be as dramatic as it is delightful. As an avid murder-mystery enthusiast myself, I'm dazzled by this long-running series that so masterfully combines thoughtful storytelling with fun, deductive crime-solving. It's no mystery why *Grantchester* continues to be a hit after nearly a decade.

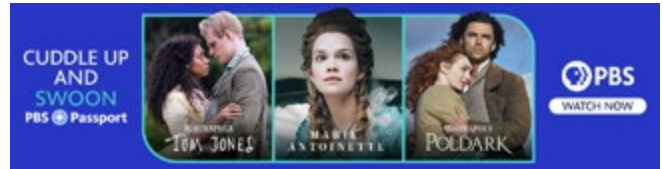

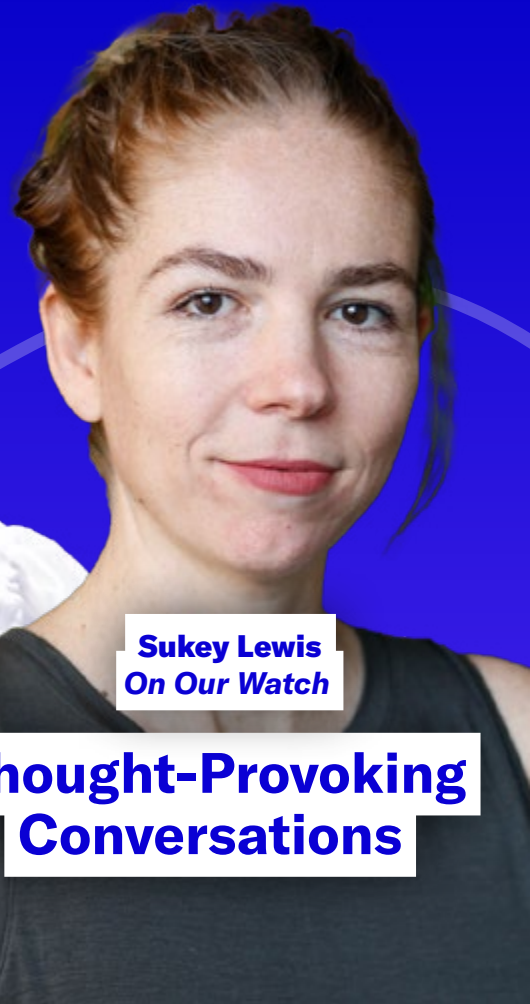
