THE MADAME BLANC MYSTERIES, SEASON 3

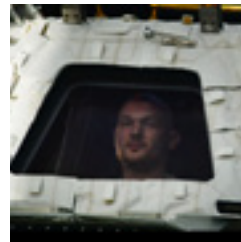

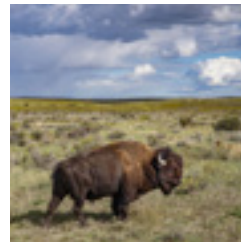
Independent Lens: Space: The Longest Goodbye
