

Resource**Work Voices #1****Elia Ruano - Radiologist**

It is helpful to view one segment at a time

Context

Elia Ruano describes her journey to becoming a radiologist. She explains the English requirements and also the how the Radiology Certificate program at Canada prepared her to practice in the field. The only education prerequisite for admission to a program is usually a high school diploma or equivalent.

Radiology certificate and diploma programs ground students in the techniques used in radiological imaging - imaging procedures and use of imaging equipment. Programs also offer contextualized learning which help students to communicate effectively in a medical environment and develop professional skills.

Preview activities/Introductory questions*Beginning level*

- What is her job title?
- What does she do?
- What do you want to know about radiology?

Intermediate

- Have you heard of this career in the medical field?
- Have you or someone you know been to a radiologist?
- What would you need to know in order to consider this career?

Vocabulary*Beginning level*

Prerequisites, diagnose, scan, flexible, determined, compassionate

Intermediate

Prerequisites, fluoroscopy, tomography, diagnostic imaging, ultra sound, CT scans, diagnose, MRI - magnetic resonance imaging, fracture, flexibility compassionate, determination, rewarding, procedures, clinic, pediatric

Focus questions

- What is a radiologic technologist?
- What are her duties?

- What are the prerequisites needed for the program?
- What personal qualities does she recommend?
- What other fields did she consider?

Discuss responses.

- Find training programs in radiology near where you live

b Job opportunities

- Look for jobs as a radiologist within your area.
- Investigate the range of positions – that is the different levels you can achieve in radiology.
- Explore the pay rates at the different levels.

Summarize findings for a and b in two paragraphs to share with the class

Reflection

- Do you think Elia likes her job?
- What questions do you still have about being a radiologist?
- What are the best things about working as a radiologist?
- What are the challenges or dangers of working in this field?

Write a short reflection paragraph in response to these questions

Contact assignment

Interview someone who is working as a radiologist **OR** someone who works in the health field in a job that interests you.
